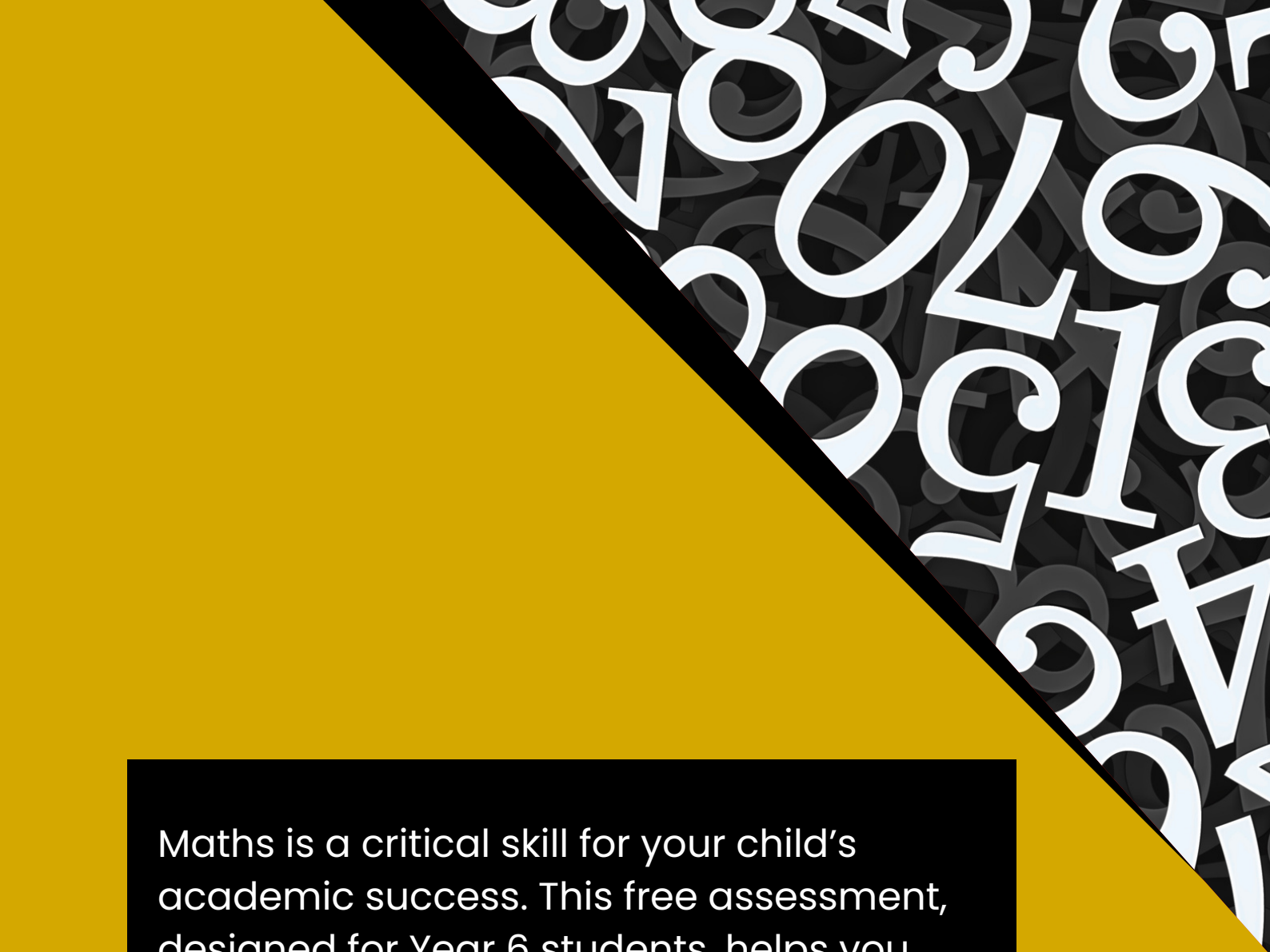

WHAT THE SCORE MEANS

0-4: Working towards the expected standard

The priority right now is building confidence in the core Year 6 topics before SATs – there is no need to rush ahead. Secure marks on the basics matter far more at this stage than covering extra ground.

5-8: On track for the expected standard

This is the zone to watch closely – not just whether they got the right answer, but how they got there. Confident, clear working is what tips a child from "on track" towards greater depth, more than a lucky guess ever will.

9-10: Working at greater depth

A high score here reflects solid understanding across most areas of maths, not strength in just one or two. That breadth – rather than any single question – is the real sign a child is working at greater depth.
